

THE MARCH ON WASHINGTON - 2013

July 1, 2013 New York Theological Seminary is proud to announce its partnership with The National Action Network and the Federation of Protestant Welfare Agencies to work together to take the messages of economic justice, and leveling the playing field in areas of access to healthcare, education, job and career opportunities back to Washington, DC, as did Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. some 50 years ago this August.

More than a re-enactment, this is an opportunity to



push forward our continued demand to pay attention to the crises that entangle the communities in which we live and work. It is only fitting that New York Theological Seminary join this March on Washington to ensure that the world knows we carry this same message and are unwilling to rest on the laurels of those who came before us.

We have secured a bus for travel and are extending an invitation to all of our alum and friends who would like to join us for this occasion.

The cost of travel is **\$55 round-trip** which will include an NYTS t-shirt to be worn on the day of travel, <u>Saturday, August 24, 2013</u>. If you already own a NYTS t-shirt, the cost is **\$50**. (We are asking that everyone wear an NYTS t-shirt that day.) The bus will leave from the vicinity of The Interchurch Center at 5:00 am on that day. The bus will return that evening. The Interchurch Center is located at 475 Riverside Drive, between W. 119th and 120th Streets, NYC.

Additional details will be released regarding the logistics of the travel arrangements as we approach the date.
