

Academic Calendar

NYTS offers courses on an academic calendar that begins July 1 and ends June 30 of each year.

The Seminary's master's degree programs operate on a two-semester (fall and spring) basis with each semester being fifteen weeks in duration. The fall semester starts the week following Labor Day in September, while the spring semester starts the last week of January or the first week of February.

Courses at the master's level are also offered in month-long intensive formats in January (called "the winterim" period); as well as in June, July and August ("the summer" period).

The DMin program is offered on a year-long basis only, with course work offered either in a semester-based format (fall and spring semesters) or in week-long intensive formats (actual times vary with programs).

CP courses are generally offered in the fall and spring on a twelve-week semester basis, but additional CP courses may be offered in the summer months as well.
