

New York Theological Consortium Cross-Registration

NYTS belongs to the New York Theological Consortium (NYTC), which also includes the Theology Department of Fordham University, Union Theological Seminary in New York, General Theological Seminary, St. Vladimir's Seminary, Jewish Theological Seminary, and Hebrew Union College. NYTS students in the MDiv or one of the MA programs who have at least a 3.5 GPA are permitted to cross-register for up to six credits of course work in any of these other schools. Students may not normally use cross-registration to fulfill a requirement in their NYTS degree program, must meet any additional prerequisites for the course or courses in which they seek to enroll, must have the approval of their NYTS academic advisor, and must comply with the enrollment procedures required by both NYTS and the other consortium school or schools. Students register for a course in one of these other schools as part of their regular registration at NYTS, paying tuition to NYTS but attending the class at the other institution. It should be noted that semester dates differ among these schools, so any student seeking to cross-register should be sure to check the starting date and register at NYTS appropriately.
